## Pocket Statistics 2015

- There were 2,802 applicants for the Bachelor of Policing degree programme which started in 2015, around 9 applicants per study place.
- 174 students completed the Diploma in Police Studies degree, with around 99% of the students graduating in the target time.
- 22 people completed the degree Bachelor in Police Command.
- More than 7,200 persons took part in training outside the degree programmes (further training organised by the Police University College, seminars and tailored courses).
- The number of personnel at year-end was 221.
- A total of 43 research publications (investigations, reports, reviews, articles) were published.
- Operating expenses totalled approximately EUR 26 million.
- The National Police Museum had over 26,000 visitors.






