15th USPE European Police Championships Swimming

28th August – 1st September 2017 in Hannover/Germany

Invitation to Enter

The German Police Sport Board of Trustees (Deutsches Polizeisportkuratorium; DPSK) was entrusted by the Union Sportive des Polices d' Europe (USPE) with the organisation of the 15th USPE European Police Championships Swimming from 28th August to 1st September 2017 in Hannover/Germany.

The following regulations are issued for the USPE EPC Swimming 2017. They have been adopted on the basis of the Statutes, Rules and Regulations, Competition Rules and Anti-Doping-Regulations of the USPE.

5. Accommodation/Travelling

The organiser will provide the transportation from Airport Hannover or Main Railway station Hannover (Hauptbahnhof) to Hotel Wienecke according to the travelling details of all the delegations.

Delegations which need a VISA are requested to contact the host in time.

Shuttles during the championships

The organiser will provide all shuttles during the EPC. The exact schedules will be given to delegations on arrival day.

6. <u>Safety Requirements</u>

The organiser has to make sure that all safety requirements are met according to the rules of the respective sport discipline. The organiser has to ensure that a medical first aid will be present at the competition.

The organiser is responsible for a safety and security analysis of the risks during the EPC to determine the necessary precautions and measures.

7. Insurance

Everyone involved in the USPE EPC is responsible for his/her own insurance cover.

The participating Member Countries are responsible for and undertake to conclude all necessary and adequate insurance cover (e.g. accident and health insurance) for their whole delegation members at their own expense for the whole duration of the USPE EPC.

Claims for damages against the USPE are expressly excluded.



8. <u>Competition rules</u>

8.1 <u>Competition Rules</u>

The provisions of the USPE Competition Rules, paragraph 4.9 shall apply.

The competition will be held with preliminary heats and finals. A direct final will be held in case of 8 or less participants per discipline/teams per relay.

An individual swimmer or relay team qualified but not wishing to take part in a final shall withdraw within thirty (30) minutes after the end of the preliminary heats concerned.

Reserves for finals will be based on times established in the preliminary heats.

In cases of withdrawal it is the responsibility of the team manager to ensure the presence of the reserve.

8.2 <u>Participants</u>

Each member union may enter up to two sportsmen/-women per individual discipline with regard to both men's and ladies' events. For the discipline "lifesaving" each member union may enter up to four sportswomen and four sportsmen.

The number of starts in individual disciplines including "lifesaving" is not limited.

One team per relay event may be entered.

Each member union may send up to 28 sportsmen/-women as well as up to four attendants. However, the number of attendants must not exceed the number of sportsmen/-women.

8.3 <u>Disciplines</u>

The following competitions will be held for male and female

- Combined lifesaving individual competition
- Combined lifesaving team competition
- 50m Freestyle
- 100m Freestyle
- 400m Freestyle
- 50m Breaststroke
- 100m Breaststroke
- 50m Backstroke
- 100m Backstroke
- 50m Butterfly
- 100m Butterfly
- 200m Individual Medley
- 4x 100m Individual Medley Relay
- 4x 100m Freestyle Relay
 - 4x 50m Freestyle Mixed Relay (2 women/2men)



The number of entries sent with Form 1a will decide the disciplines held at this EPC.

8.4 <u>Seeding</u>

The lane placing will be to the times, based on the entry time announced with Form 3. If no time is announced, the respective swimmer will be placed by draw.

The lane placing for the finals will be based on times established in the preliminary heats. In case of a direct final, the competitors/relays will be seeded according to the times announce with Form 3.

All lane placing will be in accordance to the FINA Rules.

8.5 Equipment

All teams are expected to wear uniform sportswear displaying the emblems of their individual member union.

Only FINA approved swimsuits are allowed during the competition.

8.6 <u>Decorations and honours</u>

The winner of each individual competition of an EPC is "European Police Champion".

As to relay competitions organised within the framework of an EPC, each competitor of the winning team/relay team is "European Police Champion".

Medals

Competitors taking first, second and third places in any of the individual competitions are awarded with prize medals.

As to relay events, the competitors of the relays placing first, second and third are awarded with prize medals.

Other prizes

The organiser will honor the best team to the Federation obtaining the highest number of points in both men's and women's events according to the following system

- a. in individual events using 8 lanes places 1 – 8: 18, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10 points places 9 – 16: 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 points
- b. in relay events using 8 lanes: places 1 – 8: 36, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 20 points



9. <u>Referees</u>

The provisions of the USPE Competition Rules, paragraph 2.4, shall apply.

The organiser is in charge of ensuring a sufficient number of referees. The minimum standard for referees is the highest national level.

Exceptions must be approved by the responsible member of the USPE Technical Commission in charge for the respective sport and the USPE Secretary General.

11. Jury of appeal

The provisions of the USPE Rules and Regulations, Article R 19, shall apply.



The Jury of Appeal comprised of

- 1. Fred Kusserow Secretary General of the USPE, Chairmen
- 2. Massimo Re Member of the Technical Commission
- 3. Jörg Müller Chairman DPSK
- 4. Jochen Borchert (Organiser)

All appeals have to be made in writing by the delegate or one of the attendants of the member union in question within less than an hour after the end of the fixing of or the publication of the results unless the respective international sport rules specify different.

The delegate or one of the attendants of the member union has to enclose an appeal fee with the appeal in order for the appeal to be valid.

The deposited sum will be refunded to its owner if the appeal proves to be justified.

If the appeal is rejected the sum deposited is retained by the USPE.

The appeal fee will be a total of 100.00 €, paid in cash.

12. <u>Eligibility to start</u>

The provisions of the USPE Statutes, the USPE Rules and Regulations, the USPE Competition Rules as well as the USPE Anti-Doping Regulations shall apply.

Participation in championships is restricted to athletes, who

- 1. meet the starting requirements of their international union,
- 2. belong to a national sports organisation that is a member of the USPE,
- 3. are police officers or
- 4. are police students at a public police academy,
- 5. have reached the age of 18 at the time of the championships (including preliminary rounds),
- 6. have signed the Anti-Doping Declaration and
- 7. submit the USPE Declaration of Participation signed by the respective President/Secretary General to the competent member of the Technical Commission.

In order to be able to take part in a European championship organised by the USPE, the members of the member countries have to fulfil the following conditions:



They have to satisfy the provisions set out in Article 23 of the Statutes.

They have to be police officers or students at a public police academy. The police are a set of all bodies and institutions in charge of maintenance of public law and order (administrative police and crime investigation departments).

Military police, members of the military, members of the fire brigades and civil servants that do not belong to the police are excluded from the European police championships.

Competitors suspended from sports contests by the USPE or by the respective sports association due to having violated the relevant doping regulations are not eligible to enter.

All teams shall wear uniform sportswear displaying the emblems of their individual member union.

13. <u>Accreditation/Verification of eligibility to enter</u>

For verification of a person's eligibility, the police ID and passport or national ID-card (including a photo) must be presented to the Delegate of the USPE. In case of a document deficiency, the permission to start may be refused.

According to the USPE Statutes, all participating countries must present the USPE Declaration of Participation for each athlete who will participate, signed by the respective President or Secretary General.

Without these Declaration the participation at the USPE EPC is not possible!

The competent member of the USPE Technical Commission, Mr. Massimo Re, will affect the verification.

14. Anti-Doping

Doping tests (urine and/or blood) will be conducted during the championships, with the current WADA list of prohibited substances being applicable. (www.wada-ama.org).

According to the USPE Statutes, all participating countries must present the USPE Declaration of Participation for each athlete who will participate, signed by the respective President or Secretary General.

Without these Declaration the participation at the USPE EPC is not possible!



If you take prohibited substances or use prohibited methods mentioned in the WADA Prohibited list to treat an illness or condition, you need a Therapeutic Use Excemption (TUE) to participate.

15. Financial provisions

- 15.1. <u>Travelling expenses</u> Each member union will pay its own travelling expenses.
- 15.2. Board and lodging

Delegate

The organiser will pay the expenses incurred by the delegate (USPE Rules and Regulations Article R 11) of the respective member union.

Team

For all participants are $40.00 \in$ per person/per night to be paid to the organiser (Article R 14/3 of the Rules and Regulations).

Guests

In case a member country intends to be accompanied by guests and the organiser is able to provide the respective accommodation, each guest has to pay the actual costs incurred by them. These costs are 510€perperson

Each Team and guests is obligated to indicate a billing address (e-mail) to the host. According to **Form 3** a invoice and the bank details will be sent by the host. This fee has to be paid by 15th August 2017.

15.3 <u>Registration fee</u>

Prior to a championship, each participating country has to pay a registration fee to the General Treasurer of the USPE. This fee has to be paid before the opening of the championships.

Registration fees: Each start (single/relay): 40.00 €

USPE will send the respective invoices in time.

17. <u>Restriction of personality rights</u>

Participants consent through their entry that their personal data/information shall be recorded for the entire competition and results' lists in a file and shall be published on the Internet or in USPE publications.

They also consent that photographs/film recordings produced prior to, during and after the event may be used for the purpose of USPE public relations work.

18. Disclaimer

The USPE and the hosts shall not assume any liability in the event of accidents, theft and other events of damage or loss. The disclaimer shall be recognised upon registration for the event.

19. Notes

One contestant per team has to wear the police uniform of their respective country at the opening ceremony.

All teams shall wear uniform sportswear displaying the emblem of their individual member union.

As to the Final Banquet all participants are requested to attend adequately dressed to suit the occasion (no blue jeans).
