# COMPETITION RULES

## The USPE Competition rules, item 4.3

### 4.3 HANDBALL

**4.3.1** The rules and regulations laid down by the European Handball Federation (EHF) shall apply, unless otherwise stipulated below or provided for in the Invitation to Enter.

**4.3.2** The EPC shall comprise Preliminary Rounds and a Final Round.

Preparation and organisation of the Preliminary Rounds depend on the number of engaged teams. Subject to rule 1.3.1, at least six teams take part in the Final Round. The number of participating teams is set by the USPE Technical Commission and is determined among other things to the total number of enrolled teams. The team of the organising member union is qualified directly.

Each team may enter up to 14 players and four attendants in the Preliminary Rounds and up to 16 players and four attendants in the Final Round.

All players may take part in every match of his / her team.

**4.3.3** The USPE Technical Commission determines the organisational framework of the Preliminary Rounds and the rules and regulations applicable to the Final Round.

The Preliminary Rounds should be concluded no later than four months prior to the start of the Final Round.

**4.3.4** If two or more teams have gained the same number of points from the group matches, the teams will be ranked as follows:

1. goal difference in the direct encounter of the teams
2. greater number of plus goals in the direct encounter of the teams
3. goal difference in all matches (achieved by subtraction)
4. greater number of plus goals in all matches

If the rank is still not possible, a draw decides the ranking. The draw shall be carried out by the USPE, if possible in presence of the responsible team officials. USPE – Police Sport Europe [www.uspe.org](http://www.uspe.org) 4/10 Solidarity Professionalism Open Respect Transparent

**4.3.5** If a placement match, semi-final or final ends in a draw, there shall be a five minutes break followed by an extra time of 2 x 5 minutes, with a 1-minute half-time break.

If the match is still undecided after the first period of extra time, there shall be another break of five minutes followed by a second period of extra time of 2 x 5 minutes, with a 1-minute half-time break.

If there is no winner after the second period of extra time, the match will be decided by penalty throws.

## European Police Championship in Handball Men

**EPC Handball Men**

The Danish Police Sports Association (Dansk Politidrætsforbund) was authorized by the Union Sportive des Polices d'Europe (USPE) with the organization of the 2016 European Police Championship Handball Men 2016.

A 1967, where Denmark has a proud tradition and where Denmark has previously been European champion, Germany, became 2nd in the final after the last seven Denmark.

Denmark has an 47 proud traditions in this particular sport in which Denmark has previously been European champion. The last championships was won at the European Championships in 1993 in Norway.

This Championship is held in collaboration with the Police Sports clubs in and the West Jutland football club Silkeborg-Silkeborg. The arena is named Ivo Arene.

The accommodation takes place at the nearby city hotel Scandic Silkeborg, where all the players and managers are accommodated during the championships.

The championships will take place from May 29 to June 3, with arrival on 29.05 May and matches on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Last day Thursday and same time on Friday and final and trophy ceremony on Saturday.

The following 8 teams is qualified for the championships - besides the host seven Denmark - Germany, France, Norway, Austria, Greece and Switzerland.
