Qualifying for EPC football 2014 in Prague, Czech Republic

18 member nations announced their participation in EPC football 23rd – 30th of June 2014 in Prague: Austria, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Slovakia, Switzerland, Turkey and United Kingdom.

As host Czech Republic is directly qualified for the final round according to the USPE Competition Rules.

The TC decided to have the qualification as follows:

Round No. 1

The 5 matches have to take place between <u>1st of May until 30th of September 2013</u>:

- 1. France and Germany played the final of EPC 2006 and 2010. France and Germany are directly qualified for the final round.
- 2. The teams ended up as no. 3 7 of the EPC 2010 will not take part in round 1. Switzerland, UK, Greece, Ireland and Turkey are directly qualified to round 2.
- 3. The remaining 10 teams, Austria, Bulgaria, Denmark, Finland, Hungary, Italy, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway and Slovakia, were drawn into the following five matches.
- 4. The team mentioned first is the host.

- 2. Switzerland, UK, Greece, Ireland and Turkey were drawn to play different matches in round 2.
